WHO IS WELCOME?

- The Rally is open to **anyone on a motorcycle** - **Not allowed on site - Cars, Quads and Trailers.**
- Day Visitors are welcome, but will be required to pay the **full entry fee.**

The lucky ticket holder must be **there within 3 minutes** to claim the prize; otherwise another draw will be made.



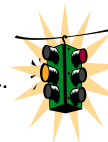
GENERAL INFORMATION
